Mr. Cambetes,

Following your request this morning, the University dispatched members of its Facility Management and Environmental Safety departments to search the above listed building for up to (5) 50" X 3/8" X 1 1/4" aluminum bars with two wires attached. It was noted in our conversation that the bars included AM241 isotopes.

The building is not occupied, most contents have been removed and utility service has been suspended. There are two primary remaining areas where some materials are stored. Today's search was of the entire building and concentrated on the remaining items in the two storage areas.

A number of suspect materials and containers were inspected. A Ludlum Geiger Counter Model 2 Serial No. PR018513 was used to test for the presence of isotopes on any suspect item or container. No response on the meter was observed in response to any of the items or containers tested today.

It does not appear the bars are in the facility.
