

Reference USNRC By product Material License Number 53-00458-04 (Human Use), Docket Number 030-03537, issued to the Department of the Army, Tripler Army Medical Center (TAMC), Honolulu, Hawaii, 96859-5000, expiration date of September 30, 1991, and Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty dated October 22, 1990.

Tripler Army Medical Center, through its attorney, David A. Little, requests an extension of 30 days to the response time to file the Reply to a Notice of Violation, and Answer to a Notice of Violation. Tripler Army Medical Center does not deny the violation, but to effectively respond, additional time is necessary. Many documents were generated by the investigation and I must acquire and review them all. My legal staff consists of one other attorney and myself to serve a staff of over four thousand. Also I must familiarize myself with the law in this area since this is my first experience with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Finally, the child who was injured in the incident of concern to the NRC is due to return to Tripler the week of November 19th for further medical evaluation. I would like to review the records of the child's upcoming visit and include that information with the Reply and Answer.
