Subject: Delegation of Authority for Radiation Safety Officer

Mr. Courtney Kerr has been appointed Radiation Safety Officer effective June 14, 2006 and is responsible for ensuring safe use of byproduct material. The Radiation Safety Officer is responsible for managing the radiation safety program; identifying radiation safety problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; and ensuring compliance with regulations for the use of byproduct material. The Radiation Safety Officer is hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet these responsibilities.

The Radiation Safety Officer has the authority to immediately stop any operation involving the use of byproduct material in which health and safety may be compromised or may result in non-compliance with Nuclear Regulatory Commission requirements.

This delegation of authority remains in effect until rescinded.

The Delegation of authority as Radiation Safety Officer issued to LaMarr G. Beuchler dated July 29, 2002 is rescinded effective June 13, 2006.
