Dear Administrative Judges:

It has come to my attention that two documents which were submitted with the "NRC Staff's List of Documents Required by the Licensing Board's Order of June 5, 2006" ("Document List"), filed on June 19, 2006, were incorrectly photocopied and produced in incomplete form. These were as follows:

- Item 15. Letter from Robert L. Tedesco (NRC) to Dr. G. G. Sherwood (General Electric Co.), dated February 4, 1981, Subject: "Acceptance for Referencing General Electric Licensing Topical Report NEDO-24154/NEDE-24154P," with enclosed "Safety Evaluation for the General Electric Topical Report Qualification of the One-Dimensional Core Transient Model for Boiling Water Reactors, NEDO-24154 and NEDE-24154-P" (June 1980).
- Item 16. "Supplemental Safety Evaluation for the General Electric Topical Report Qualification of the One-Dimensional Core Transient Model for Boiling Water Reactors, NEDO-24154 and NEDE-24154-P." ¹

Notwithstanding this error, the Staff notes that these two documents were reproduced and filed

in complete form by Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Operations,
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Inc. (collectively, "Applicant"), as part the GE LTR which the Applicant filed on June 19, 2006.²
Accordingly, inasmuch as the Licensing Board and parties are in possession of these
documents in their entirety, they are not being reproduced a second time by the Staff.

The Staff regrets any inconvenience which may have been caused by this inadvertent error.
