Summary:	I spoke with Mr. Smiley about the request to amend the license to remove the prohibition against the administration of byproduct material to animals used for food and the request for an expedited review. I explained that an expedited review could not be granted since an exemption from the license condition and 10 CFR 33.17(a)(4) would need to be approved. Additional information would be needed such as a study of the eluant from the Molybdenum-99/Technetium-99m generator for contaminants and a beneficial reason why the exemption should be granted. Exemptions of this nature require review by NRC Headquarters because they relate to policy issues and take time. Mr. Smiley stated that the research was being conducted on a prize cow for a fair and it was unlikely that they would be able to control what happened to the cow after the study. Mr. Smiley decided that the action should be voided.
