SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

On March 14, 2006, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC staff has reviewed your NRC Form 314 (termination request). Based on its review, the staff has concluded that you will not use byproduct material in NRC jurisdiction greater than 180 days in any calendar year. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. NRC license number 46-27644-01 is hereby terminated.
