Dear Dr. Terry:

This is in reference to your letter dated June 3, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-25637-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. The attestation statement by Dr. John J. Wurtzbacher for Dr. Terry to become an authorized user did not state some specific experience elements as required by 10 CFR 35.290. Please submit information attested by an authorized user stating Dr. Terry's work experience in calculation, measuring and safely preparing patient or human research subject dosages (10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii)©), using administrative controls to prevent a medical event involving the use of unsealed byproduct material (10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(d), and eluting generator systems appropriate for preparation of radioactive drugs for imaging and localization studies, measuring and testing the eluate for radionuclidic purity, and processing the eluate with reagent kits to prepare labeled radioactive drugs (10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(g).
