PURPOSE: Sidebar meeting to discuss progress on environmental report to support new facility license application.

BACKGROUND:

DISCUSSION:

1. Ur-Energy presented its progress on its environmental report for a pending new facility license application.
2. Ur-Energy stated that it intends to submit a license application for a satellite ISL facility in the summer of 2007. Ur-Energy intends to purchase an existing license and develop the Lost Soldier and Lost Creek properties as satellites. At some future point in time, Ur-Energy will construct a processing facility on one of these properties.
3. Steve Ingle raised the issue of well abandonment procedures for existing wells and borings. He stated that Ur-Energy should review the procedures to ensure that the well/bore plugs will not uplift during pressurization.
