- 12. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every 3 months to account for all sealed sources and devices containing licensed material received and possessed pursuant to 10 CFR 35.59, 35.400 and 35.500 incorporated by reference and 6 months for all other sealed sources and devices.
- 13. The licensee may transport licensed material, or deliver licensed material to a carrier for transport, in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapter 230, "Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material" and the provisions of 10 CFR Part 71 incorporated by reference.
- 14.
