Dear Mr. Allard:

We have reviewed your May 5, 2006 e-mail in response to our December 13, 2005 regulation review letter which identified necessary revisions and recodification due to the Part 71 rule revision and six rule amendments that have become due and will need to be adopted since the 2003 review. We have reviewed the final Pennsylvania regulations, 25 PA. Code Chapter 215 which address the six additional rule amendments and the proposed rule recodification due to the Part 71 rule revision. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC regulations in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 31, 32, 35, 40, 70, and 71 and the requirements of the 7 amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Mr. Louis Ray Urciuolo on July 10, 2006.

As a result of our review, we have three comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that if these regulations are revised, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when you revise your regulations to address our comments, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in STP Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the location of any changes made by Pennsylvania, in response to our comments and provide a copy to STP.

Additionally, we understand that Pennsylvania plans to address the requirements of NRC Order EA-05-090 (Increased Controls for Risk-Significant Radioactive Sources) through Order until such time as NRC adopts regulations to address these requirements. Pennsylvania will need to adopt and submit these legally binding requirements to the NRC for a compatibility review prior to becoming an Agreement State.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Pennsylvania regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. Thus, for a state to adopt the essential objectives of 71.101(b), as would be required under compatibility category C, it would be inadvertently required to adopt requirements contained in provisions reserved to the NRC.</p> <p>Recognizing this discrepancy, staff members are re-reviewing the compatibility designation of the referenced sections. No changes to the Pennsylvania regulations are required until the NRC completes its review of part 71 and reports its results to the state.</p>
