Summary:	<p>Prior to closeout of Inspection 2005-001, the licensee was contacted to discuss their future intentions regarding the removal and storage of DU from linear accelerators. The licensee indicated that they did not intend to take possession of any additional accelerators containing DU in the future.</p> <p>Since the license is unclear on whether removal of the DU from accelerators is allowed, the licensee indicated that they would submit a license amendment request clarifying their intent and describing the safety precautions taken for handling, contamination control, storage, inventory, and disposal of DU.</p>
