To Whom It May Concern:

Neotropix Inc (Neotropix) of Malvern, Pennsylvania, NRC License No. 37-31129-01, would like to request the NRC increase our license limit for S-35 as detailed below and in the attachment.

Neotropix is requesting this increase to allow us to perform additional studies needed to advance our research without nearing or potentially exceeding our current limit. The purpose(s) for which licensed material will be used will remain the same. We will be utilizing recent hires in addition to our existing users to perform additional studies. The recent hires have experience with radionuclide use and have been trained in accordance with our license conditions and NRC requirements. They will be working under our current authorized users.

Considering the addition of new staff and the relatively low energy of S-35 we do not expect existing staff exposure to increase significantly. Nor do we plan for the maximum amount currently used at one time to increase. We simply want to ensure our limits allow for an increased number of studies as well as room to perform decay in storage.
