

With regard to your email to Mary Beth Taormina on July 13, 2006, we are submitting the additional information you requested for our license amendment. We confirm the following conditions:

1. Authorized users will receive the minimal training and experience required by the Radiation Safety Committee.
2. The review of the facilities will ensure that the floor beneath the self-shielded irradiator is adequate to support the weight of the irradiator; the self-shielded irradiator is secured to prevent unauthorized access or removal; and the area where the self-shielded irradiator is located is equipped with an automatically operated fire detection and control system (sprinkler, chemical, or gas) or the location of the area and other controls ensure a low-level radiation risk attributable to fires.
3. Operating and emergency procedures will be developed, implemented, maintained, and distributed and will meet the Criteria in the section entitled, "Radiation Safety program - Operating and Emergency Procedures" in NUREG - 1556, Vol. 5, dated October, 1998. Changes to operating and emergency procedures will be reviewed and approved by the RSC and affected licensee staff will be trained in the procedures before they are implemented.
