NRC STP-06-051 "OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON THE CHANGE IN BASIS FOR THE NATIONAL SOURCE TRACKING SYSTEM (NSTS)"

- The ultimate goals specific to the protection of the U.S. public from undo harm from certain types and quantities of radioactive materials of concern can be adequately met by either of the two implementation mechanisms under discussion.
- The discussion points then become ones of resource management, consistency of implementation, dual oversight of licensees, ability to conduct cooperative efforts between regulators with common goals and remaining within a mindset that emphasizes reasonable evaluations of relative risk and consequence.
- Maryland is in favor of this state, under health and safety (compatibility "B"), overseeing the implementation of our portion of the NSTS. This is with the exception of those Maryland facilities that have implemented additional security in accordance with previous NRC issued Orders
 - ✓ NRC should amend the licenses of those facilities that have previously been issued NRC security orders to include requirements of the NSTS.
 - ✓ Maryland is willing to provide resources for the implementation the NSTS for all other required facilities.
 - ✓ Maryland has been willing and has shown the ability to cooperatively and effectively implement other similar projects involving the licensing and inspection of licensee's with radioactive materials of security concern.
 - ✓ Licensees may be more comfortable and compliant when local and potentially more assessable state radiation programs coordinate regulation of radioactive material.
