The purpose of this modification is to revise Contract Clause H.3 2052.209-72 CONTRACTOR ORGANIZATIONAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST (JAN 1993), Paragraph (c) WORK FOR OTHERS, Subparagraph (3), pursuant to the Waiver of Commission "Work for Others" Requirement for Avoidance of Contractor Organizational Conflicts of Interest, approved by Luis A. Reyes, Executive Director for Operations, dated May 2, 2006. Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

Delete Contract Section H.3, Paragraph (c)(3), in its entirety and replace as follows:

When the contractor or NRC contractor inspectors perform work for the NRC under this contract at any NRC licensee or applicant site, the contractor and its inspectors shall neither solicit nor perform for that licensee or applicant organization, corrective actions or other work resulting from inspection findings at the site which are generic to other sites owned by the licensee/applicant organization, for a period commencing with the award of the task order or beginning of work on the site (if not a task order contract), and ending one year after completion of all work under the associated task order, or last time at the site (if not a task order contract). Any future work by the contractor or one of its subcontractors employing inspectors for other sites (collectively not individually) owned by the same licensee organization (specifically during the one-year restriction after the task order concludes) in areas technically dissimilar to the new design/engineering inspections (which are not prohibited above) shall not exceed any monetary compensation received from the NRC per year or \$300,000 per year, whichever is the greater.

All other terms and conditions of the contract remain the same.
