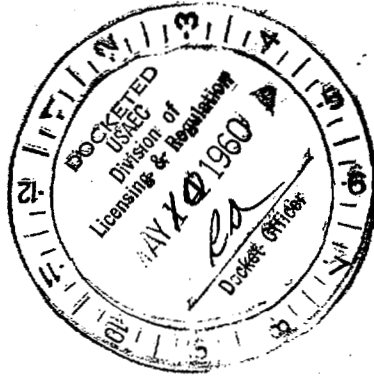

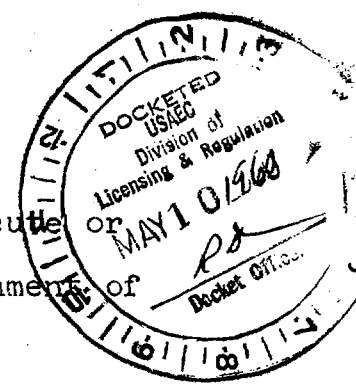

ASSIGNMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that ENGELHARD HANOVIA, INC., a New Jersey corporation (hereinafter called the "Assignor"), having a principal place of business in the City of Newark, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, in consideration of the sum of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR and other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby assign unto ENGELHARD INDUSTRIES, INC., a Delaware corporation (hereinafter called the "Assignee"), having a principal place of business in the City of Newark, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, and the Assignee does hereby accept the assignment of all of the rights, privileges, duties and obligations of the Assignor under a certain agreement made by the Assignor, or by a corporation merged with the Assignor on the 31st day of December, 1957, with **the Atomic Energy Commission, United States of America, dated the 26th day of August, 1959,**

subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Assignor agrees that it will execute or procure any further necessary consent to the assignment of said agreement.



2. The Assignee does hereby covenant and agree that it shall and hereby does indemnify and save harmless the Assignor against any claim that may be made against the Assignor arising out of the said agreement after March 31, 1960 and shall pay any judgment that may be recovered against the Assignor as a result thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, ENGELHARD HANOVIA, INC. and ENGELHARD INDUSTRIES, INC. have caused these presents to be signed by their duly authorized officers and their corporate seals to be affixed hereto this 31st day of March, 1960.
