 - A. Please submit documentation of the specific training and experience of the proposed Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Mr. Emery Roberts, including the specific dates of certification and/or training in radiation safety.
 - B. Please submit documentation to show that the proposed RSO has a minimum of 2,000 hours of hands-on experience as a qualified radiographer in industrial radiographic operations.
 - C. Please submit documentation to show that the proposed RSO has obtained formal training in the establishment and maintenance of a radiation protection program.

 - A. Please submit alternative information demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience (e.g., Board Certification by the American Board of Health Physicists, completion of a bachelor's and/or master's degree in the sciences with at least one year of experience in the conduct of a radiation safety program of comparable size and scope).
 - B. Please submit documentation to show that the proposed RSO has obtained formal training in the establishment and maintenance of a radiation protection program.
