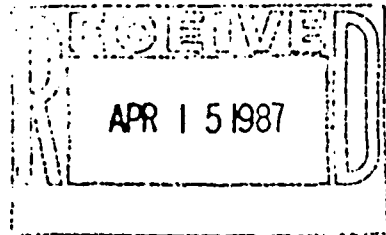

This is a followup to the telephone report to your office this morning (April 10) concerning the event earlier today involving the raw water supply pipeline to our Sequoyah Facility.

We temporarily suspended plant operations pending repair of the pipeline. Repairs are expected to be completed later today; however, the temporary suspension of operations may exceed one shift and the repair cost may exceed \$2,000.00. Hence, we are providing this written notice in accordance with 10 CFR 20.403.
