The purpose of this letter is to provide a response to the questions that you submitted under letter dated July 28, 2006. Below are the questions that you asked, along with our responses:

1. Does the redemption of shares of a shareholder of AOAM require a license amendment?

Response: No. The redemption of shares of a shareholder of AOAM does not require a license amendment.

2. Does issuance of shares of AOAM to a licensed physician require a license amendment?

Response: No. The issuance of shares of AOAM to a licensed physician does not require a license amendment.

3. Does change of members of the Radiation Safety Committee (RSC) require a license amendment?

Response: 10 CFR Part 35, Section 35.24 (f) requires that certain Part 35 licensees establish a RSC. If your license requires that you have a RSC, you are responsible to assure compliance with the regulations. A license amendment is not required when you change membership as long as you comply with Section 35.24 (f).
