SUBJECT: TRANSITION OF REGULATORY OVERSIGHT OF THE AMERICAN
CENTRIFUGE LEAD CASCADE FACILITY

Dear Mr. Toelle:

On March 24, 2004, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), "Cooperation Regarding the Gas Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facilities at the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant" was completed. This MOU addressed, among other items, the regulatory oversight roles and responsibilities for both the DOE and NRC for USEC Inc.'s (USEC's) American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility (Lead Cascade). Prior to transition to NRC regulation, the DOE had primary regulatory oversight responsibilities. Transition to NRC regulatory oversight, as discussed in the MOU, was expected to occur following NRC's pre-operational inspections and regulatory compliance reviews but prior to the introduction of uranium hexafluoride into the Lead Cascade.

The NRC has recently performed pre-operational inspections to verify that the facility had been constructed in accordance with the requirements of the license. Based on these inspections, the NRC concluded that USEC had met the conditions of the license and demonstrated that the facility has been constructed and will be operated safely and securely and in accordance with the requirements of the license. By letter dated August 23, 2006, NRC authorized USEC to introduce uranium hexafluoride in the Lead Cascade following the regulatory oversight transition date.

Therefore, as discussed in a conference call on August 22, 2006, between USEC, NRC, and DOE, and in accordance with the MOU, regulatory oversight for the Lead Cascade's nuclear safety and appropriate aspects of safeguards and security will transition from DOE regulatory oversight to NRC regulatory oversight on August 25, 2006, at 12:01 a.m. The transition of regulatory oversight responsibilities will occur as documented in the MOU.
