Request That Previous Correspondence No Longer Be Considered Proprietary

On March 13, 2006, Amarillo Power, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of Texas, notified the NRC of its intent to submit by the end of 2007 an application for an Early Site Permit (ESP) for a two-unit reactor site in the vicinity of Amarillo, Texas. Amarillo Power stated it plans to construct and operate two GE Advanced Boiling Water Reactors at the ESP site and to submit a Combined Construction Permit and Operating License application as soon as practicable after submitting the ESP application. In that letter and attached affidavit, Amarillo Power requested the letter be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §§ 9.17(a)(4) and 2.390(a)(4).

The information in the Amarillo Power letter of March 13, 2006, as restated above, remains accurate but is no longer considered proprietary by Amarillo Power. There are no commitments
