Mr. Kennedy was identified as a person with relevant information by Mr. Miller in his initial disclosures and is referenced in Mr. Miller's responses to written discovery questions.

For the above stated reasons, the Staff requests the Board to issue the attached subpoena to Mr. Kennedy.
