Gentlemen:

In conformity with the requirements of Part 110, Unclassified Activities in Foreign Atomic Energy Programs, the Atomic Energy Commission is hereby notified that Engelhard Industries, Inc. has entered into an agreement with the Comitato Nazionale per l' Energia Nucleare, Rome, Italy.

Under the terms of the above agreement, Engelhard sells to the CNEN certain nuclear fuel element manufacturing equipment which was located in the D. E. Makepeace plant at Plainville, Massachusetts. In addition, "technical data" comprising manufacturing know-how in unclassified areas is to be transferred to the CNEN.

The agreement was signed in Rome on July 27, 1962.
