# SUBJECT: CRYSTAL RIVER NUCLEAR PLANT - NRC SECURITY BASELINE INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-302/2006007

Dear Mr. Young:

On April 24, 2006, the NRC completed the onsite portion of a security baseline inspection at your Crystal River Nuclear Plant Unit 3. Portions of Inspection Procedures 71130.01, Access Authorization, and 71130.08, Fitness for Duty, were completed at the Progress Energy Corporate office on February 10, 2006. The enclosed report documents the inspection results, which were discussed with Mr. Eugene Martin, at the Corporate office, on February 10, 2006, yourself and other members of your staff on March 23, 2006 and April 24, 2006.

This inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection no findings of significance were identified. However, a licensee-identified violation which was determined to be of very low safety significance is listed in Section 4OA7 of the enclosed report. The NRC is treating this violation as a non-cited violation (NCV) consistent with Section VI.A.1 of the NRC Enforcement Policy because of the very low safety significance of the violation and because it is entered into your corrective action program. If you contest this NCV, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator; the Director, Office of Enforcement, United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC Resident Inspector at the Crystal River Nuclear Plant.
