Dear Mr. Cushing:

As environmental and consumer groups representing members of the public, we are writing regarding NRC's Federal Register Notice on July 12, 2006. The Notice announced the availability of the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the North Anna ESP site and set a public meeting on the issue. The meeting was announced for August 15, 2006 – the evening before a previously scheduled public hearing by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on the water impacts of new reactors at the North Anna ESP site.

We are concerned about the unusual back to back scheduling of these meetings. Both meetings are at the same location and are likely to be of interest to the same local stakeholders. Moreover, the Virginia DEQ's hearing was arranged several weeks prior to NRC's announcement. As people have to work during the week and must often arrange for child care in the evenings, it would be difficult for them to attend both meetings. Such an arrangement is not conducive for real public participation, and it is unacceptable for a federal agency to set public meetings at times when it is obviously difficult for the interested public to attend.

We strongly recommend that NRC reschedule the hearing to a later date in order to allow full public participation in both hearings.
