Dear Mr. Dixon:

This refers to your letter dated May 8, 2006, requesting NRC consent to the proposed change of ownership and control of NRC License No. 34-06943-02, issued to U.S. Inspection Services. Based upon our review of the information you provided, the NRC consents to the change of ownership. Amendment No. 13 is enclosed.

The transferee should note its new responsibility and liability as an NRC licensee. Specifically, responsibility is emphasized with regard to any ongoing NRC inspection and enforcement issues, investigations, facility decontamination, and decommissioning funding resources.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
