Dear Sir:

In accordance with SNM-124, Condition S-23, Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. (NFS) is providing notification of a change in permit limits to the state –issued National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. NFS received the permit on July 5, 2006. The State of Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation issued the permit on June 30 with an effective date of August 1, 2006. The only permit limit that changed was the nitrate plus nitrate nitrogen limit that changed from 558 lbs/day (maximum amount) to 420 lbs/day (maximum amount). NFS has incorporated the change into the appropriate operating procedures.
