John Mohart, M.D. is a Fellow in Cardiology in the program approved by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) at Barnos-Jewish Hospital/Washington University during the period from 1 July 2002 through 30 June 2005. During the fellowship period, Dr. Mohart has undertainen training in Nuclear Cardiology at this institution. This training is being accomplished in two ways. First, Dr. Mohart received his most intervelve training within the organized structure of our ACGME-approved training program in nuclear medicine and nuclear radiology. His supervised work experience and supervised otheriosi experience were accomplished during rotations in the Division of Nuclear Medicine totaling 3 months in duration. In addition, Dr. Mohart is serving in the capacity of research fellow in noninvestve cardino imaging from July 2004 through June 2005. During this intervel to has epent the equivalent of 3 additional months receiving supervised training and clinical experience in cardiovascular nuclear medicine. In the Division of Nuclear Medicine. During this training experience Dr. Mohart has provided Nuclear medicine in the approximation and radionuclide anglographic studies. Moneover, he obtained coronary anglographic correlation in more than 30 of the atudies. Dr. Mohart is receiving additional instruction in the basic aciences partment to cardiovascular nuclear medicine as part of his 1-year research experience.
