

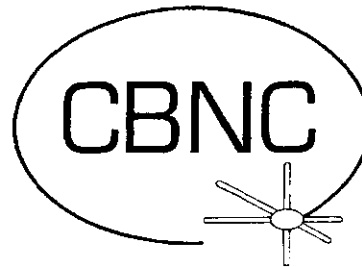

John Mohart, M.D. is a Fellow in Cardiology in the program approved by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) at Barnes-Jewish Hospital/Washington University during the period from 1 July 2002 through 30 June 2005.
