

TEST RESULTS

Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) performs random testing of the workforce at an annual rate of at least 50 percent in accordance with 10 CFR 26.24(a)(2). For the six-month period beginning January 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2006, random screens were performed at a rate of approximately 32 % of the WCNOC population.

WCNOC submitted blind performance specimens in accordance with 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Section 2.8(e)(2), requirements. There were no reportable events.

WCNOC Employees

One employee tested positive for alcohol during a follow-up test. Unescorted access was suspended. An evaluation was completed and unescorted access was reinstated. The individual was placed in a follow-up program.

Contractors

During this reporting period, no contractor tested positive for drugs or alcohol.
