Dear Mr. Kollmansberger:

By application dated June 15, 2006, you requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission terminate your NRC radioactive material license, License No. 48-18031-01, (expiration date of October 31, 2013) which authorized portable gauge usage only (no fixed facilities involved for either use or storage) at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material. In that application, you related that on June 1, 2006, all six gauges possessed/used under License No. 48-18031-01 were transferred to your State of Wisconsin issued License No. 025-1167-1 for portable gauge usage in that State and that you no longer have intentions of transporting gauges to non-agreement states for use. You also provided current leak test records confirming the non leaking status of the sealed sources in all six gauges transferred and confirmed that no leaking sealed sources have ever been identified based on routine leak test data. Based on information you have provided to us, we have concluded that licensed material is no longer used or possessed under NRC License No. 48-18031-01, and that appropriate criteria are met that permit us to terminate the license as requested. Accordingly, an amendment is enclosed terminating your NRC License No. 48-18031-01.
