Summary:	According to Mr. Garelick, waste being returned from Beth Israel does go past a Ludlum 177 monitor, but the I-131 waste of 07/06/06 did not set off an alarm. St. Barnabas takes waste from 6-7 other hospitals, but he doesn't know whether or not any others treated an I-131 inpatient during the time in question. He believes that this waste came from Beth Israel because the waste workers at St. Barnabas told him that most of the waste in the barrel containing the I-131 came from Beth Israel, especially the hot portion.
