<u>Summary Of Management Actions Based on Positive Test Results for Marijuana, Cocaine, and Alcohol:</u>

Thirteen (13) Access Denials

Five contractors tested positive for alcohol.

Eight contractors tested positive for drugs (One individual tested positive for both marijuana and cocaine).

Refusal to test

One contractor was denied for refusal to provide/cooperate on a random drug and alcohol test. Another contractor was denied for refusal to provide/cooperate on a for-cause drug and alcohol test.

Subversion

One contractor tested negative for drugs, however was denied for subversion during a pre-access test. The observed for-cause test was returned with a negative result.

One contractor tested negative for drugs, however was denied for subversion during a pre-access test. The observed for-cause test was returned with a positive result for marijuana (also included as one of the eight contractors who tested positive for drugs above).
