2) Physical Description

This shipment will consist of 480 drums of Uranium Ore Concentrate (U-308) in 10 x 20' ocean containers. The total weight of the shipment is 190,115.1 kgs of U-308.

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3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel will sail from Hamburg, Germany on March 11, 2001. The ocean transportation from Hamburg, Germany to Montreal, Quebec, Canada will be the responsibility of CANMAR Steamship Line. The vessel will unload at Montreal, Quebec, Canada on or about March 20, 2001. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Detroit, MI. The containers will enter the USA at Detroit, MI on or about March 26, 2001, and will continue on rail to St. Louis, MO. The inland transportation from Montreal, PQ to Metropolis, IL will be the responsibility of RSB logistic Services Inc.


