Status of Recommendations

<u>Recommendation 1:</u>	Re-certify and re-accredit IPSS based on an independent, comprehensive, and fully documented assessment of all management, operational, and technical controls.
Response Dated July 28, 2006:	Certification and accreditation for IPSS will be completed as part of the agency Information Systems Security Program. While the completion date for IPSS has not yet been established, the tentative projected date for completion of Recommendation 1 is December 14, 2007. In order to expedite the certification and accreditation process, the Office of Administration has completed the first set of certification and accreditation documents including the Privacy Impact Assessment, NRC Forms 616 and 637, Security Categorization Document and the e-Authentication Risk Assessments.
OIG Response:	The proposed action addresses the intent of OIG's recommendation. Recommendation 1 will be closed after OIG has reviewed documentation showing that the re-certification and re-accreditation of IPSS is complete.
