I appreciated our time together today. Thank you for your patience and being a great listener.

I talked with [REDACTED] tonight. He saw [REDACTED] couple of weeks ago and told me [REDACTED] is consulting and serving on Nuclear Review Boards. It sounds like [REDACTED] is at his home [REDACTED] for some period of time. Here is [REDACTED]'s contact info:

I met [REDACTED] this evening unexpectedly; he was in the area for school (undergrad program at University of Phoenix in King of Prussia). He had a lot of details to share about nuclear safety decision-making, including the 'reactivity management' event at Hope Creek and another time not too long ago when they had to take the Hope Creek unit offline because of significant unidentified leakage in the drywell. He had detailed information about having to battle senior management to take the unit offline. I asked him if he thought we (PSEG Nuclear) were safe. He said yes because the guys with the licenses can be trusted to do the right thing, defying senior leadership's directives if they have to. I encourage someone to talk with [REDACTED].

I would appreciate you calling me when you have time. I know you are out of town Thursday morning.
