To Whom it May Concern:

This correspondence serves to report the incident which involved one of our nuclear, moisture density gauges. This letter serves to report the incident as required by 10 CFR Ch.1 §30.50. The equipment damaged was a Troxler 3411, serial number 10942, including the following isotopes:

- CS-137, serial number 40-8387, with a current activity of 5.4mCi
- AM-241:BE, serial number 47-6341, with a current activity of 38.8mCi

The incident occurred at approximately 14:00 on Saturday, July 1, 2006. The incident occurred on a project site known as "Rydal waters" which is located near the terminus of Brook Road in Abington Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. To the best of our knowledge the gauge was damaged by a bull dozer when a certified user left the gauge unattended for a period of approximately five minutes.

The outer casing of the gauge was completely destroyed, but the source was found to be intact and to be suitable for shipment according to the results of the survey meter in the field. In addition, the surrounding area was not found to contain any radioactivity above background levels. The damaged gauge has since been leak tested and has been deemed suitable for transport to the manufacturer for disposal.

Since the incident has occurred, the NRC, specifically Mr. Sattar Lodhi and Mr. Michael Reichard, have conducted reviews of our gauge storage facilities and field operations.

To date we are awaiting the results of our exit interview with the NRC. Should you have any questions or require further clarification, please do not hesitate to contact me.
