Dear Mr. Blackburn:

This is in reference to your letter dated August 11, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. SNM-1993. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- 1. Your application should have been signed by a management representative. Your title was not shown on the letter, nor was there any indication that you are the management representative authorized to represent the licensee. As stated in section 10.13 of NUREG-1556, Volume 15, "Representatives signing an application must be authorized to make binding commitments and to sign official documents on behalf of the applicant." Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license. If you are the authorized management representative, please provide information supporting that designation.
- 2. In your letter you stated that the requested change does not constitute a change of control. From your letter it is our understanding that the name and address of the licensee (ARCO Environmental Remediation, LLC, La Palma, CA) will not change, only the mailing address of the administrative contact. Please confirm that this is the case.

Or you may obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-888-293-6498. We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 139282. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call me at (610) 337-5308.

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
