Straight Talk from Chris Bakken

As you know, I have consistently made an effort to keep you informed of issues as they arise and to make certain you are not caught by surprise by reading information in the local papers. In that spirit, you should know that a former employee, Kymn Harvin, has today released several audio tapes to local newspapers. She made these tapes without the knowledge or consent of the individuals she taped. We understand the tapes she released to the newspapers capture the voices of two former business leaders, Harry Keiser and Tim O'Connor, as well as one current employee, Larry Wagner.

Because Ms. Harvin has filed a complaint against the company and because it is a matter of ongoing litigation, our response to press questions must be limited to our confirming the circumstances of her separation from the company and our awareness of a series of employee tapes. We expect to issue the following press response:

Kymn Harvin's position at PSEG was eliminated as the result of a reorganization within PSEG Nuclear. Her position was not eliminated because she raised safety concerns about the work environment at the station. The Company is aware that Ms. Harvin taped conversations with certain associates without their knowledge or consent. She has been required to produce those tapes as part of her ongoing litigation against the Company.

Because the matter is in litigation, we will not go beyond confirming the reason for her separation and the existence of the tapes.
