The comment period ended May 30, 2006. No public comments were received. However, the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR) requested minor clarifications, which have been incorporated. A red-line strike out of the changes is included. These are the only changes made to the policy statement since 71 FR 10568. A determination was made by the Office of General Council that NSIR's clarifications were not significant enough to require another public comment period, per telecom between Sher Bahadur and Stuart Treby on August 10, 2006.
