Pursuant to a discussion held with U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff on August 29, 2006, USEC Inc. hereby submits a Nuclear Criticality Safety Analysis report NCS-RPT-AC-04 (Revision 1) that contains information related to USEC's comment number 81 submitted by USEC letter AET 06-0095, dated August 25, 2006. This reference report is being submitted as Enclosure 1 of this letter.
