Enclosed is Amendment No. 02 to your NRC Material License No. 21-32364-01, in accordance with your request by letter dated July 11, 2006, and our conversation by telephone on September 18, 2006. Also, please note that due to our current licensing guidance, we have modified License Item 8. A. (to specify a possession limit for the activity of licensed material) and License Condition 13. F. (regarding leak test criteria) as well as deleted License Condition 24., which specified a possession limit, no longer needed due to the possession limit added to License Item 8. A. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
