Since 1964, North Carolina has also been regulating the radioactive material that is now included in the expanded definition of byproduct material under the Energy Policy Act of 2005, which places this material under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

I am writing to inform you that I intend to make a certification to the Commission, as provided in Section 651(e) of the Energy Policy Act of 2005, to allow North Carolina to continue regulating the radioactive materials now defined as byproduct materials.
