On September 1, 2006, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff participated in a closed meeting with the staff from USEC Inc. (USEC) to discuss issues associated with transportation security plans for shipping classified security materials from the Lead Cascade site in Piketon, Ohio. The current security plan addresses 10 CFR 95.39(c)&(e).

Issues discussed include the following:

- The frequency of contacting the commercial carrier while en route;
- Shipping manifests and licensee and shipper emergency contacts;
- Coordinating shipments with state level law enforcement agencies;
- Hand carrying items;
- Identification of "safe havens" en route; and
- Contract provisions for the licensee to be contacted within a specified time if there is any problem (traffic accident, vehicle failure) with the shipment.

Additional discussions with USEC on these issues are expected.
