

Withdrawal of Remote Shutdown and Post-Accident  
Monitoring Instrumentation TS Change

In FPL letter L-2005-056 dated April 21, 2005, FPL proposed changes to the St. Lucie Technical Specifications based on generic changes that have been made to the Improved Standard Technical Specifications (ISTS), NUREG-1432, *Standard Technical Specifications for Combustion Engineering Plants*, based on Technical Specifications Task Force (TSTF) travelers that were previously reviewed and approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. FPL also proposed changes to remote shutdown and post-accident monitoring instrumentation based on the ISTS.

Subsequent FPL interactions with the NRC staff on the proposed remote shutdown and post-accident monitoring instrumentation changes led to the FPL decision to withdraw the proposed changes related to the remote shutdown and post-accident monitoring instrumentation.
