On November 29, 2000, Roanoke College's radiation safety officer (RSO), Dr. Frank Munley, sent a letter to Mr. Wade Loo of NRC stating our request that RSO responsibilities be transferred from Dr. Munley to Dr. Richard Grant. The request was approved. Before this request was made, Dr. Munley was in the process of renewing our license (45-10085-04). Dr. Munley worked out a number of details with the help of NRC staff and didn't complete the license application until January 29, 2001, when it was mailed in. Due to an oversight, Dr. Munley rather than Dr. Grant signed it, whereupon NRC reinstated Dr. Munley as the RSO. Dr. Munley was never officially informed of this reinstatement, so at this time I would like Dr. Grant to be recognized as the college's RSO.
