Red Rose Cardiology & the Office of Ellen K. Smith, M.D. FACC, Request for Additional Information Concerning Application for a License Amendment, Control 139419

Dear Ms. Bethany Porter,

This is in reference to your letter dated September 12, 2006, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-30854-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- 1) Based on the documents presented, it appears Dr. Smith has 74 hours of classroom and laboratory training of a minimum of 80 hours required. There are 10 clock hours of supervised on the job experience listed that may be used for the total 700 hour requirement, however experience hours may not be used for classroom and laboratory training. Please review these hours to determine if it was work experience or laboratory training.
- 2) Please provide information to the dates and locations when the experience requirements of 10 CFR 35.290(c)(ii) was obtained and the number of hours of experience.
- 3) The attestation statement from your preceptor, Dr. Paul Collura, needs to include the classroom and laboratory training, specifically list the experience elements as stated in 10 CFR 35.290(c)(ii), and have the statement that Dr. Ellen K. Smith has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently and as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. It is recommended that you use NRC Form 313A to document the training, experience, and attestation statements for an authorized user. This document may be obtained by going the URL: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc313a.pdf>. Ensure you list all experience attributes as listed in 10 CFR 35.290(c)(ii).
- 4) Based on the information presented, Frank Bloe may not be used as a preceptor because the material license 34-26645-02 is not a medical license.
- 5) Your license has authorization for 35.100 and 35.200 materials. Your amendment request removes all authorized users for 35.100 materials. Do you wish to remove the authorization for 35.100 materials or do you wish to authorize Dr. Smith for 35.100 also?

Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter or facsimile (610-337-5269). If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
