Subject: 3-2002-004 Concerns

Sorry, what a mess! I ended up speaking with Heller and he was even more confused. There were three allegation numbers involved, resulting in a total of 2 concerns being accepted by OI for 3-2002-004. 3-2002-004 has Concern 2 (RIII-2001-A-0176) as the primary allegation, with Concern 3 (RIII-2002-A-0114) as the secondary allegation. I added it in and called it, "Deliberate False Statements by Supervisor".

The discrimination allegation, Concern 4 (RIII-2002-A-0114) is the concern OI accepted for 3-2002-020. I double checked this and it appears correct.

Allegation #RIII-2002-A-0042, Concern 1 was closed out to RIII-2001-A-0176 by EICS. This is the allegation that [redacted] failed to self-report and this allegation was also alluded to in Concern 2 of the original -0176 allegation. This is why we had a total of 3 allegations in the OI report. For writing purposes, I spun this out as another allegation (but not technically a third concern). Heller said we don't need to reference RIII-2002-A-0042 since his records will show that it was closed out to -0176. 7(c)
