WELDER FOR RAISING FITNESS FOR DUTY CONCERNS
(OI CASE NO. 3-2002-020; AMS RIII-2002-A-0114)

On August 5, 2002, [REDACTED] a contract welder, formerly employed by Day & Zimmerman Nuclear Power Systems at the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant, was interviewed by Mary Kay Fahey, Special Agent, Office of Investigations (OI), Region III (RIII), concerning his allegations of employment discrimination.

Attached is a copy of [REDACTED]'s transcribed interview for the staff's review of any additional potential safety/technical concerns. Please note that [REDACTED] was originally scheduled to be interviewed concerning allegations involving a Fitness For Duty (FFD) concern at Kewaunee (OI Case No. 3-2002-004; AMS RIII-2002-A-0042). After [REDACTED] contacted EICS concerning an allegation of employment discrimination, he was interviewed by OI on both concerns. The pertinent pages relative to [REDACTED] discrimination complaint are found at pages 1-12; 42-61. Upon completion of the staff's review, an ARB needs to be scheduled to determine the investigative priority.

Since both OI investigations are pending, please ensure that appropriate measures are taken to safeguard the dissemination of the transcript and related information. OI approval is required for disclosure of this interview.
