Surry unit 2 tripped saturday evening and surry power station declared an alert sat. Evening @ around 6:00 pm and lifted the alert sunday morning @ around 6:00 am. The action was not related to any offsite problem. Unit w continued (and continues) to operate.

The state is aware of the situtation at surry, and did not enhance their normal eoc watch staff. @ocal jurisdictions within the surry epz have not reported any concerns or asked for any state assistance.

Based on the foregoing, and my conversation with art and bill, there is no reason for a disaster initated review at the surry power station.
